

Be a Reformer! Leader's Guide

- 1. What are some areas of culture that need to be reformed? (Our families, government, media, churches, and schools all need to be reformed.)**
- 2. Who does God want to use to reform our broken culture? (Christians. You!)**
- 3. Isaiah 61:4 says, "They will rebuild the ancient ruins". What does this tell us? (Even if things have been in ruins for a long time, they can be rebuilt!)**
- 4. What does Isaiah 61:4 tell us about cities? (Cities can be restored, repaired, and made new.)**
- 5. Why was Nehemiah sad about Jerusalem? (The walls of Jerusalem were broken, and the gates were burned.)**
- 6. What did God want Nehemiah to do? (God put it on Nehemiah's heart to repair the broken wall.)**
- 7. Where did Nehemiah get supplies to repair the wall? (The king he worked for gave him wood. See Nehemiah 2:8.)**
- 8. Was it easy to rebuild the wall? Explain. (NO! Enemies tried to stop the work. They made fun of the workers, fought them, and made plans to kill them.)**
- 9. Did Nehemiah succeed? (Yes, because he didn't give up.)**
- 10. How do you feel about your city/town? Do things seem hopeless? Explain. (You may feel discouraged about the crime, racism, drugs, violence, etc. in your city. You should remember that nothing is impossible with God!)**
- 11. Has God given you a dream? Do you think he wants you to be a builder? (Answers will vary. Everyone is different, and there's no pressure if you're not a builder! Be open to becoming a reformer even if this is a new idea!)**
