Changing Your World Leader's Guide

- 1. What happened to the world when Adam and Eve sinned? (Sin and death entered the world.)
- 2. What happened to Adam and Eve when they sinned? (They lost their authority to rule over the world. They gave that authority to the devil.)
- 3. How did Jesus' death reverse the effects of the fall? (Jesus regained authority over the earth and took away ALL the devil's authority.)
- 4. What huge assignment did Jesus give to his followers? See Matthew 28:19-20. (He asked them to change the planet, to make disciples, disciple nations, to make the nations look like heaven.)
- 5. What is baptism? (A public outward act indicating an inner change.)
- 6. What do we need to teach new disciples? (We need to teach them God's ways. We need to teach them to obey all that Jesus commanded his original disciples.)
- 7. What is a reformer? What are some areas that need reform in our world? (A reformer brings long-term change to a culture. We need to reform areas of government, education, family, media, business, arts and entertainment, and religion.)
- 8. How can Christians be reformers in the area of media? (They need to report accurately, truthfully, and to try to find happy endings to stories. They need to bring solutions when they present problems.)
- 9. How can Christians be reformers in the area of family? (They need to carry God's love and acceptance to others and not reject them.)
- 10. How can Christians reform the arts and entertainment world? (They need to lift people's spirits, not bring in perversion or darkness. They need to ask God to express His creativity through them.)
- 11. How can Christians reform government? (They can stay humble, avoid corruption, bribes, and abuse of power. They can pray for solutions to government problems.)
- 12. How can Christians reform business? (They can invite God into every financial decision, be generous, and give away as much as possible.)

- 13. How can Christians reform the area of religion? (They can follow Holy Spirit's leading, being sensitive to His voice. They can stay open to the supernatural and NOT tolerate the spirit of religion.)
