- 1. How did God start the first government? (He gave Adam and Eve the job of managing and governing the earth.)**
- 2. List 3 governmental titles (names) given to God in Isaiah 33:22. (King, lawgiver, and judge.)**
- 3. How does God share his authority with people according to Romans 13:1? (God puts rulers in their places of power.)**
- 4. Why does God like government? (He wants order, not chaos and violence.)**
- 5. Romans 13:4 says those in authority are God's servants. How do they serve Him? (Rulers are supposed to help and protect people. Their job is to punish evil doers and to bring justice.)**
- 6. Jeremiah 29:7 tells us to work for the good of our city, to be good citizens. What are some ways we can do this? (We can vote, get involved, and pray for our local, state and national governments.)**
- 7. What can we do if our government is corrupt or evil? (We can pray! Prayer is powerful! We can ask God to remove evil leaders and bring in good ones. We can pray for evil laws to be changed.)**
- 8. What actions can we take to change our government? (We can call or email our lawmakers and give them our opinions.)**
- 9. God cares about government. He wants you to care too. Do you? If you don't care, are you willing to pray that God will change you? (Answers will vary.)**
