Living by Faith Leader's Guide

- 1. How can we please God? What is he looking for? (We can please God by having faith. He's looking for FAITH.)
- 2. What is faith? (Faith is knowing that God is real even if we don't see Him. It's believing in the unseen, invisible God.)
- 3. How do we enter the kingdom of God? (By believing that Jesus died on the cross for our sins and receiving the free gift of forgiveness by FAITH.)
- 4. Why did God decide to destroy the people of Noah's day? How did He do it? (The people were violent, cruel, and hurting each other. God decided to destroy them with a flood.)
- 5. What instructions did God give Noah? How did he choose to live by faith, not sight? (God told Noah to build an ark for himself and his family. There had never been a flood. It didn't look like a flood was coming. Noah obeyed anyway.)
- 6. Were God's words fulfilled immediately? Did God lie? (No. It took a long time to make the ark, perhaps up to 120 years. As soon as Noah and his family were safely in the ark, God sent the flood. He didn't lie!)
- 7. What big problem did Abraham have? (He had no son, and his wife was infertile or barren.)
- 8. What did God promise Abraham when he told him to look at the stars? (He promised Abraham would have as many descendants as the stars.)
- 9. What circumstances in Abraham's life looked impossible? Did he stop believing? (Sarah was too old to have a baby. Her womb was dead! NO! He kept believing.)
- 10. When Sarah was 89, what did God tell her? How did she react? (She would have a baby the next year. She laughed!)
- 11. Did God come through? (Yes! She had a baby at the exact time God said.)
- 12. What impossible situation do you need to believe God for? (Answers will vary.)
