

Battlefield 12 - Leader's Guide

1. What are some reasons we might believe God is not fair? (Satan uses trauma to plant this lie in our minds. If we had parents who were impossible to please, who mistreated us, gave more attention to our siblings, or did not protect us, we might believe this.)
2. What does the Bible say about God's justice and fairness? (God is always just. He never treats anyone unfairly. He shows NO favoritism and never does wrong.)
3. God appeared to Solomon in a dream. What did He say? See 2 Chronicles 1:7. (He said, "What do you want? Ask and I will give it to you.")
4. What did Solomon ask for? See 2 Chronicles 1:10. (He was young and inexperienced, so he asked for wisdom to rule God's people with justice.)
5. How did God feel about Solomon's request? (He was pleased! He said he'd make Solomon wiser than anyone who'd ever lived! He'd also give him riches and honor even though Solomon didn't ask for them!)
6. Why were the 2 prostitutes arguing? (Both of them had babies, and one of the babies died in the night. Each woman said the living baby was hers.)
7. What fair and just ruling did Solomon give? (He said he would cut the living baby in half. The true mother said no. The false mother said yes. Solomon gave the baby to the mother who wanted the baby to live.)
8. What parable did Jesus tell about God's justice and fairness? (There was a mean judge who didn't want to give justice to a widow. She didn't give up. Finally, he gave her justice because she was wearing him out!)
9. How does God compare to the mean judge in the story? (He's the complete opposite! Even the mean judge gave justice! God is kind, just, and fair - of course, He'll give justice!)
10. What should we do if we need justice? (Go to God and ask Him. Don't take revenge, punch someone, or use a gun! Wait for God to right every wrong!)
